

The eighth discriminating factor

3. The class' struggle in the socialist society


The historical contributions of the socialist countries built during the first wave of the proletarian revolution and the teachings of their experience.

The mass line as principal method of work and direction of every communist party.


5. The struggle between the two lines in the communist party

Let the Communists of the imperialist countries unite their forces for the renewal of the communist movement

The present conditions quite confirm Marxist analysis of capitalist mode of production. They create a context extremely favourable for socialist revolution. However, in order to avail themselves of this favourable context, Communists have to break with *dogmatism*, which prevents them from seeing the new forms of the old contradictions of capitalism, and with *economism*, which reduces Communists to be mainly the most resolute and farsighted animators and leaders of workers' and popular masses' claiming struggles.
